Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to your application dated 21/3/97 to establish a new school under Rule 44 of D.S.E.R 73, I am directed to state that the appropriate authority after considering the particulars specified in the application form has accepted the proposal to establish a new school from Class I to VIII in Naugoi area Zone 14 of District West.

2. The said acceptance to establish new school in Naugoi area Zone No. 14 of District West shall be limited only for period of 3 years.

3. The acceptance to establish new school will automatically lapse, if the society/Trust fails to obtain recognition from the appropriate authority after fulfilling the conditions of recognition, as laid down in rule 50 & 51 of DSER, 73 and Sub-Section (E) of Section 4 of D.S.E.A, 73 within a period of 3 years.

4. Standard preliminary norms are endorsed for favour of your appraisal and guidance.

REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE CONDITIONS FOR
RECOGNITION OF SCHOOL

1. The school has an approved Scheme of Management from the Appropriate Authority in reference to provision of rule 59 of the Rules read with sub-section (1) of section 5 of the Act.
2. The School is run by a Society registered under the Societies Registration Act 1860 (21) of 1860, or public trust constituted under any law for the time being enforced.
3. The Scales of pay and allowances, medical facilities, pension, gratuity, provident fund and other prescribed benefits of the employees of the school shall not be less than those of the employees of the Directorate of Edn. reference sub-section (1) of section 10 of the Act.
4. The school is not run for profit.
5. The building or other structure in which the school is carried on, its surroundings, furniture and equipment are adequate as under:-
 - a) One classroom for each section of 40 students. @ 10 Sq.ft. per student. The minimum size of a room should not be less than 20'X15' atleast to accommodate 30 students per class/section. The rooms should be properly cross ventilated. The rooms should not be closed from three sides.
 - b) There should be atleast eight classrooms in those schools who want EC from class Ist to VIIIth. If the EC is granted from Nursery to class, VIIIth, there should be at least 10 class rooms of the above mentioned size in addition to other rooms as detailed at (c), (d) and (e) below.
 - c) There should be one room for the Principal/Head of the school of the size of 15'X10' and a room/lobby for parents and the receptionist of the same size. The minimum area of a classroom should not be less than 300 Sq.ft.
 - d) There should be one multipurpose room for Science/Sports Games etc. of the size 20'x20' for Middle Classes but ~~XXXXXX~~ separate such rooms for Secondary/Sr. Secondary Classes.
 - e) One staff room be also provided as per number of teaching Staff.
 - f) Proper facilities for drinking water, toilets and first aid be provided, separate toilets for boys girls and separate toilets for ladies and gents staff be also provided.
 - g) PLAYGROUND: Suitable playground in the school or vicinity adjoining to school for games and sports be made available.
